PROOF OF IMMUNIZATION POLICY

EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 3RD 2021

Please be advised that in accordance with Manitoba Provincial Health orders, all clients and guests must provide evidence of being fully vaccinated (2 doses plus 14 days) to enter any event space at the Centre.

Acceptable forms of vaccination status are:

- Manitoba Immunization Card or QR Code
- National Defence Canada Covid-19 Vaccine Record / Card
- Canadian Public Health Association (CPHA) Travel Vaccination Record
- An official document issued by a Canadian province or territory containing information of a person's COVID-19 vaccination history

Photo ID is required to be validated against the valid proof of immunization provided.

Children aged 11 and under are able to attend with an adult that has presented valid proof of immunization that matches their photo ID provided. Children aged 11 and under are not required to provide photo ID.

Children aged 12 and older are required to present valid proof of immunization as indicated above. Photo ID is encouraged but is not required.

Rules and restrictions at public gatherings are determined by Manitoba Public Health officials. As such the Centre reserves the right to change or modify rules and regulations associated with these gatherings.
